

RadarOpus support for Screen resolution issue

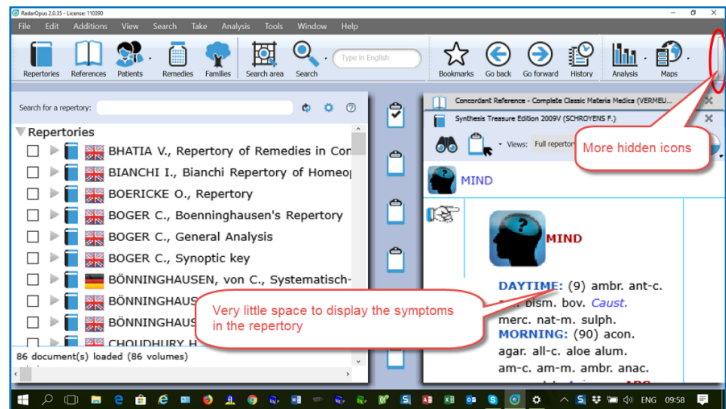
RadarOpus 2.0.35 or higher is adapted to the latest high-resolution video cards.

It might occur after installation of the 2.0 that the video settings you had before, with for example RadarOpus 1.43, are not correct anymore.

This can be easily corrected if you follow the instructions below.

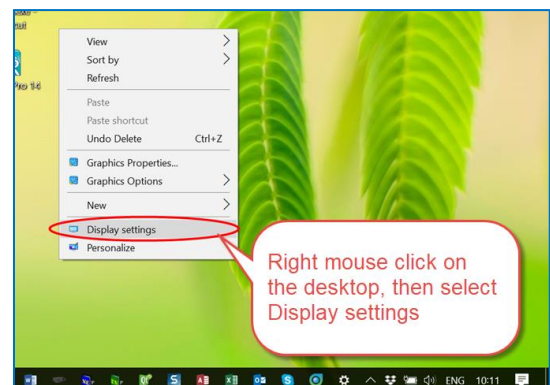
It might look for example like this screen:

Try to have as many toolbar icons visible in the toolbar via the below settings.



Adapting screen resolution settings for Windows

- Switch off RadarOpus
- Right mouse click on the desktop (not on any icon)
- Select Display settings

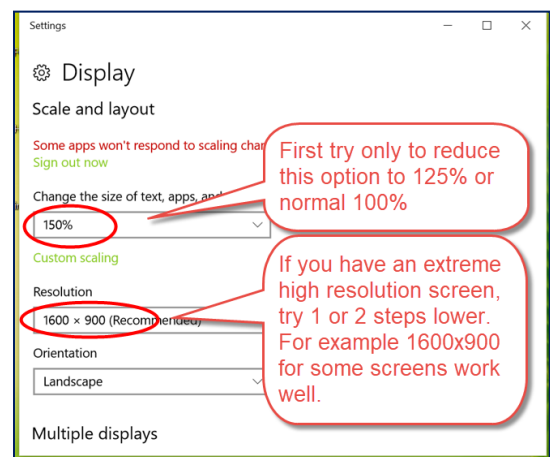


- Then in the Display settings window, check if the option "Change the size of text, apps, and other items". Change this to only 125% or the normal size 100%.

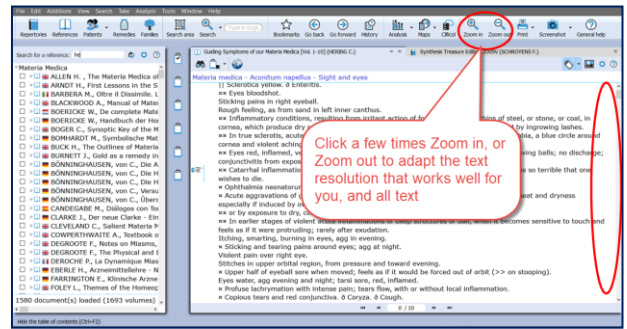
Start RadarOpus and see if you are happy with the result?

- If the result is still not optimal, try to lower your extreme high screen resolution with one of two steps. For example 1600 x 900 is a resolution that works well with many most screens.

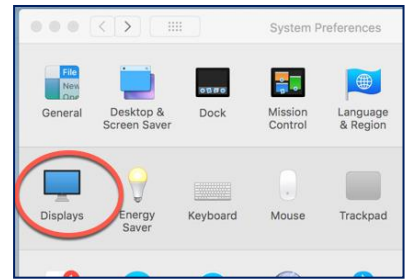
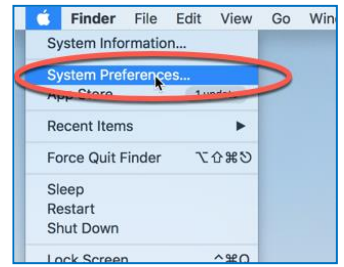


- Start RadarOpus and also adjust with the Zoom in and Zoom out icons the font size to what you like best.

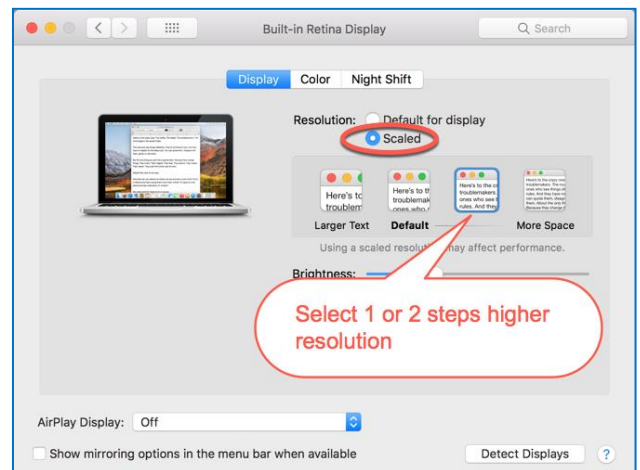


Adapting screen resolution settings for MAC

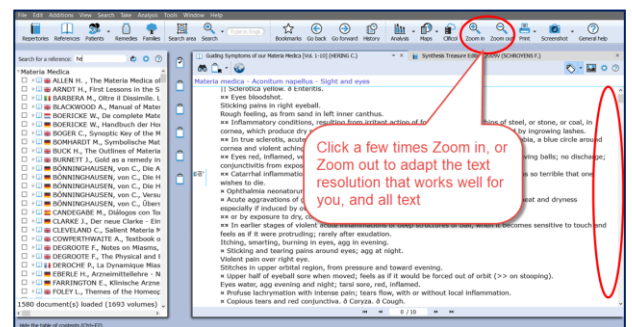
- Switch off RadarOpus
- Via the **Apple** menu, select **System Preferences**
- Then select **Display**



- Select for Resolution **Scaled**
- And try to select one or two higher resolution setting.
- Start RadarOpus and see if you are happy with the result?



- Start RadarOpus and adjust with the Zoom in and Zoom out icons the font size to what you like best.
